- Willingness to commit to the time, details, and responsibility to this position.
- Find and secure location for practices.
- Willingness to travel for practices.
- Chaperone the group.
- Must attend 2 orientations, practices, and the event in Nebraska.
- Provide instruction on the specific team discipline.
- Provide practice on the specific discipline events.
- Provide outside competition opportunities when available.
- Manage 4-H owned equipment and keep records of material/supplies and equipment use.
- Enjoy working with teenagers!
- Possess leadership skills, manage stress, and make learning fun.
