

Herding Group: In 1983 the Herding group broke off from the Working group of dog breeds. These dogs are instinctual at gathering, herding and protecting livestock such as cows and sheep. They are naturally intelligent and responsive to being trained to do specific jobs and work closely with their human counterparts. German Shepherds are part of this group and are commonly trained for police and protection work. Some other breeds in this group that you might recognize are: Border Collies and the Shetland Sheepdog (Sheltie).

Hound Breed Group: These breeds were all developed to pursue warm-blooded game. Scenthounds rely on their powerful noses to trail their quarry, from animals to humans. Sighthounds use their ability to use wide vision and powerful speed to chase prey. Theses dogs can be very focused on their quarries and use this ability to center all of their attention on that goal. Familiar breeds would be the Beagle, Greyhound and Daschund.

Terrier Group: Bred to go underground to flush out rodents and vermin, these dogs usually have short legs and are quite feisty. Longer legged breeds dig out the pests rather than burrow in the holes to get the prey out. Many of these dogs are prized as companion dogs today. Some breeds you might recognize are: Scottish Terriers, Russell Terriers, and MInature Schnauzers.


