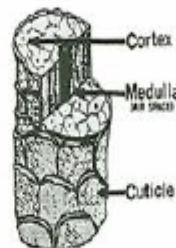

A healthy sheep is a happy sheep! Knowing what is “normal” for your sheep can be a matter of life or death.

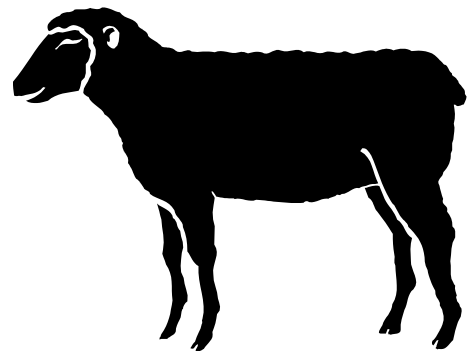
Do you know:
