

2025 Call For Nominations FERC Lifetime Influence & Impact Award

DEADLINE: February 1, 2025

Presented to individuals who have provided sustained and distinguished leadership toward the growth and development of family businesses and/or family business research and scholars

Instituted in 2015, this award is the highest form of peer recognition in family business studies. It is presented to individuals who have provided distinguished leadership over a number of years toward the growth and development of family business research. Through dedicated efforts, this individual has enabled the entry and/or the career progression of scholars into the field, while influencing family business research, education and/or practice.

Nominees may include individuals who have....

- Impacted and influenced others through advising, research, teaching, or mentoring;
- Cultivated knowledge in the field;
- Cultivated others in the field;
- Facilitated the growth of the field;
- Trained others in the field;
- Served as leaders in research, teaching, advising, mentoring or other ways;
- Demonstrated persistence in their contributions, leadership, and influence to family firms, research and others.

Nomination and Selection Process

A FERC representative (or designate) will serve as the non-voting Chair of the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee will consist of three to five voting members selected by the FERC representative.

NOMINATION PACKAGE (submitted as a single PDF file) must include the following information and should be sent via e-mail attachment in PDF format to Donald O. Neubaum (dneubaum@fau.edu).:

- **NOMINEE** name, contact information (address, phone number, email)
- NOMINEE Curriculum Vita
- NOMINATOR name, contact information (address, phone number, email)
- **STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE** of the depth of the nominee's impact on the field of family business studies (500 words, and up to 10 supporting letters, maximum 500 words for each letter):
 - o Impact as a leader on the development of the field of family business studies;
 - o Impact in the development and growth of family business scholars and practitioners;

Additional Guidelines:

- A nominee's file will remain in the pool for subsequent award years if not selected in the immediate year.

- Recipient must be present at the FERC Annual Meeting to receive the award and will be notified of their award by March 1, 2025.
- The Award may not be made every year.
