

## CAPS Psychiatry Services Insurance Fees/Reimbursement Responsibilities

Please take a few minutes to read and understand the fees associated with Psychiatric Services at UVM. Your insurance coverage determines your out of pocket expenses for these services.

Visit Fees for Psychiatric Services		
Initial psychiatric evaluation:	\$200.00	
Follow up psychiatric visits:	\$65.00+ Fees are based on length and type of visit.	

## No Show Fees for Psychiatric Visits \$50.00

Appointments cancelled with less than 24-hour notice will be charged a no-show fee of \$50.00

## If you have UVM Student Health Insurance Plan/Wellfleet:

A. Initial psychiatric visit is covered at 100%.

B. Follow up visits are covered at 80%.

C. You are responsible to pay the 20% co-pay, which will be billed to your student account at the time of the visit.

## If you have private insurance such as Blue Cross, Cigna, MVP etc.:

A. Your student account will be billed for the entire visit fee at the time of each visit.

B. UVM does NOT bill insurance companies for psychiatric visits. Therefore, it is your responsibility to submit documentation to your insurance carrier for reimbursement.

C. Psychiatry Services at the UVM Center for Health and Wellbeing (CHWB) is not listed with insurance companies as a participating provider. Therefore Anne Clegg, MD and Anna Leavey, PMHNP will not provide their individual unique provider identification number, tax identification number, and will not themselves directly bill any insurance company for your reimbursement for your Psychiatry Services at CHWB. Anne Clegg, MD, Anna Leavey, PMHNP may be listed at another site that is eligible to bill insurance for their services. However, these sites are not associated with Psychiatry Services at the UVM Center for Health and Wellbeing and such other sites cannot bill for your services at the UVM Center for Health and Wellbeing.

D. UVM Center for Health and Wellbeing (CHWB) will NOT accept direct payments from any insurance company. Charges are billed directly to your student account at the time of the visit. No exceptions will be made to accommodate any insurance or individual, since we are NOT a participating provider with outside insurance.

E. You can print a walk out statement to submit to your insurance company for possible reimbursement by following the instructions on the MyWellbeing portal.

F. It is your responsibility to discuss reimbursement and coverage issues with your insurance carrier.
