

Ergonomics In The Workplace There are increased hazards with working from home including less daily movement, working from dining room chairs or living room couches, and isolation. This page is designed to help you prevent long-term ergonomic injuries. One of the results of this new work pattern is an increase in the number of painful conditions

involving the back, neck, wrist, and head. The major factor contributing to these injuries is the long period of time a person sits in a chair. Another is the increase in repetitive motions required with the


