Action Exhibit Title: _____

An excellent action exhibit captures people's attention and engages an audience in an educational presentation. Each participant explains a step (or two) of a process using visual aids/props until the entire process or concept has been explained. While the second speaker starts to speak, the first speaker invites others to listen and begins their part of the presentation again, thus each speaker will be speaking simultaneously to a small audience that moves along the exhibit. The presentation is generally repeated for at least one hour. You must have at least 4 participants age 8 and older to be eligible for Eastern States Exposition so that two can present and two can take a break. **A six foot table is all that is provided for exhibitors. All other materials must be brought by the participants.** Below you will find an evaluator's opinion as to how effective your action exhibit is. Read their comments to see what they think would improve your action exhibit. **Thank you for exhibiting your work!**
